




THERE IS A MAN ON THE CROSS

The Rev. Reymond Hartmann *PRAYER OF CONFESSION (Unison) O Thou who art love, and who seest all the suffering, injustice, and misery which reign in this world: Have pity, we implore thee, on the work of thy hands.
