The Importance of **RMMO**

Following God's call does not come without certain sacrifices. Retired ministers, missionaries and their widowed spouses often have limited options to adequately plan for the future. Medical problems, relocating or the death of a spouse can also cause these leaders to find themselves far from the church family that once supported them.

RMMO provides financial support for the retired ministers, missionaries and widowed spouses who have helped build our churches. This assistance restores the lifeline and ongoing connection to the ABC family. Like anyone else, retired ministers and missionaries experience anxiety and worry when unforeseen costs arise.
